



Management Styles relative to colours

RED : Reds manage in a goal orientated way. They are direct and no nonsense.
Red people are not driven by money, they are driven by results

ORANGE: Oranges manage in a tolerant, constructive, supportive manner.
They judge their success on popularity, not how much money they have in the bank

YELLOW: Yellows manage in an impulsive spontaneous way. They are ambitious, and forward thinking. They need to know that there is money in the bank and usually have long term investment.

GREEN: Greens manage in a sensible, systematic way. They are accurate, discreet and realistic, they give more than they receive and often feel that the work they do should come from the heart and not the desire to make money. They often feel they don't have enough and choose careers that don't pay well

BLUE: Blues are group orientated, and delegate well. Blues amass money easily but also know how much respect they have earned.

VIOLET: Violets have to believe in what they work for, whereas a Blue can work for "just the money". They also have to enjoy what they do and they think on a global scale.

WHITE: As idealists, Whites often take risks and believe that money is energy. They often create through confusion
